

that we are sinners and turn towards God for help, but we must also believe, for the Lord commands us to "*repent and believe the Gospel*" (Mark 1:15). To believe is to be fully persuaded that something is true and must be received.

But what specifically do we need to believe? "*If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved*" (Romans 10:9-10). Confess means to admit by saying with your mouth to God, that Jesus died for your sins on the cross, was buried, and rose again to give you eternal life. Believe this with all your heart and ask the Lord Jesus to save you from sin and its penalty. "*For whosoever* (Put your name here.) *shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved*" (Romans 10:13). Just ask the Lord to save or deliver you from your sin and its penalty in Hell forever. True repentance is like a coin, on one side is to believe, and on the other side is to repent. Repent and believe go hand in hand.

Will you repent and believe today?

Will you repent or change your mind right now concerning your sin and the direction your life is taking? Turn to God from your sinful ways, and believe with all your heart that Jesus' death on the cross was to pay for your sin. "*Behold now is the accepted time; behold,*

now is the day of salvation" (II Cor. 6:2b). If you would call or ask the Lord Jesus to save you right now, He will do it. Avoid the fire of Hell and be cleansed of all your sin. "*The blood of Jesus Christ [God's] Son cleanseth us from all sin*" (I John 1:7). "*Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ and thou shalt be saved*" (Acts 16:31). Do not put your decision off another day.
